Mental Health Caregivers Support Group



Mental Health Caregivers Support Group meets in person at South Church (41 Central St. Andover, MA), and on Zoom on **the third Sunday of each month, from 7:00-8:30pm**.

Although this group meets at a church, religious affiliation is neither expected nor centered in the meetings, although those who are comfortable are invited to participate in a short prayer to close each meeting.

Important Reminders

Andover Public Schools require a new Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check every school year for anyone who volunteers at a school or school event (i.e. field trip chaperones, volunteers for class parties, library duty, etc.). If you would like to volunteer during the 2022-2023 school year, please fill out the APS CORI check form and return it in person to a school administrator with an original government issued ID. Blank forms are also available at the front office. It can take 2-3 weeks for your application to process and you will not receive a notification once it's complete. You can confirm your status with the front office.
