Spring is always a busy time of year at Bancroft! Here's a comprehensive list of all PTO events planned for the remainder of the year:






Volunteering Reminder — Important!




Andover High School Building Update

This is a confidential group where people can be heard and supported without judgement.

Mental Health Caregivers Support Group meets in person at South Church (41 Central St. Andover, MA), and on Zoom on **the third Sunday of each month, from 7:00-8:30pm**.

Although this group meets at a church, religious affiliation is neither expected nor centered in the meetings, although those who are comfortable are invited to participate in a short prayer to close each meeting.

Important Reminders

Andover Public Schools require a <u>new</u> Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check every school year for anyone who volunteers at a school or school event (i.e. field trip

chaperones, volunteers for class parties, library duty, etc.). If you would like to volunteer during the 2022-2023 school year, please fill out the APS CORI check form and return it in person to a school administrator with an original government issued ID. Blank forms are also available at the front office. It can take 2-3 weeks for your application to process and you will not receive a notification once it's complete. You can confirm your status with the front office.
