Special Town Meeting on Monday, November 20



- Article 1: Whether or not to keep Open Town Meeting or move to another form of government,
- Article 2: Property tax limit for residents 65 and older,
- Article 3: Retiree health care premiums,
- Article 4: Town Meeting speaking limits and time clock,
- Article 5: Reduce the speed limits on several roadways under municipal jurisdiction,
- Article 6: Establish and report key performance indicators of vehicular traffic safety,
- Article 7A: Approve or reject the funding for a schematic design to determine the cost of new construction for Andover High School,
- Article 7B: Approve or reject the funding for a schematic design to determine the cost of renovating Andover High School.

The Town of Andover will host a series of in-person and virtual public information sessions prior to the November 20, 2023 Special Town Meeting, focusing on the Town-sponsored articles related to funding for the Andover High School Building Project (Articles 7A and 7B). Presenters will provide an overview of the articles and answer questions from attendees. Click here to learn more.

Special Town Meeting! To register go to https://andoverma.myrec.com/info/default.aspx Click on "Programs" (the person icon) on the top left. From there, scroll down to Rec Events and you'll see Town Meeting Babysitting listed.

In order to attend town meeting you must be an active voter. To check your voting status, click here. If you are not registered to vote, you must do so no later than tomorrow to be able to attend the meeting. Town offices will be closed in observance of Veteran's Day, however the Board of Registrars of Voters will be holding extended hours on Friday 11/10, 8:30AM to 5:00PM, at the Public Safety Center (32 North Main Street). Residents with a license or other ID issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles can also register online here.

This will be the first Town Meeting at which residents will vote by electronic voting device. Doing so will allow for faster votes, ensured accuracy, and anonymity. The voting devices will be distributed to voters at voter check-in. Voters can begin checking-in at 6:00 P.M., so please arrive early to allow time to park, check-in, receive your electronic voting device, and find your seat before the meeting is called to order promptly at 7:00 P.M.
