



Join Us for Our First Ever "Walk & Talk" Event



We couldn't accomplish a fraction of what we do without the amazing support of our families and the volunteers who help make each and every event a success. We understand that life is unpredictable and sometimes our volunteers have to cancel at the last minute. But we ask that if you have to cancel within 48 hours of a scheduled event, including library volunteers, please reach out to us directly at <u>communications@bancroftpto.org</u> and let us know. Please don't just delete the signup entry, as we may not see that in time to make other arrangements. We also ask that you make an attempt whenever possible to find someone to take your spot. Many thanks for your understanding and continued commitment to our students.

Important Reminders: CORI

Andover Public Schools require a <u>new</u> Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check every year for anyone who volunteers at a school or school event (i.e. field trip chaperones, volunteers for class parties, library duty, etc.). If you would like to volunteer during the 2023-2024 school year, please fill out the <u>APS CORI check form</u> and return it in person to a school administrator with an original government issued ID. Blank forms are also available at the front office. It can take 2-3 weeks for your application to process and you will not receive a notification once it's complete. You can confirm your status with the front office.

Town Meeting

Andover's 2024 Annual Town Meeting will begin on **Monday, April 29 at 7:00pm** at the Collins Center for the Performing Arts at Andover High School. Andover voters will have the opportunity to weigh in on the FY2025 budget, adoption of a new Town Seal, how the town is governed in the future, and a host of other important topics.

A Special Town Meeting will be held beginning on **Tuesday, April 30 at 7:00pm** to consider adoption of Multifamily Overlay District to achieve compliance with the MBTA Communities zoning law.




Earth Day in Andover
