We're looking forward to a great day that will not only help our Bancroft community, but the planet too!




## **PTO Volunteer Cancellation Policy**

We understand that life is unpredictable and sometimes our volunteers have to cancel at the last minute. But we ask that if you have to cancel within 48 hours of a scheduled event, including library volunteers, please reach out to us directly at <a href="mailto:communications@bancroftpto.org">communications@bancroftpto.org</a> and let us know. Please don't just delete the signup entry, as we may not see that in time to make other arrangements. We also ask that you make an attempt whenever possible to find someone to take your spot. Many thanks for your understanding and continued commitment to our students.

## **Important Reminders: CORI**

Andover Public Schools require a <u>new</u> Criminal Offender Record Information (CORI) check every year for anyone who volunteers at a school or school event (i.e. field trip chaperones, volunteers for class parties, library duty, etc.). If you would like to volunteer during the 2023-2024 school year, please fill out the <u>APS CORI check form</u> and return it in person to a school administrator with an original government issued ID. Blank forms are also available at the front office. It can take 2-3 weeks for your application to process and you will not receive a notification once it's complete. You can confirm your status with the front office.


