Here in fourth grade we hope that you are just as excited for the first day of school as we are. We are looking forward to starting our year with you at Bancroft School.

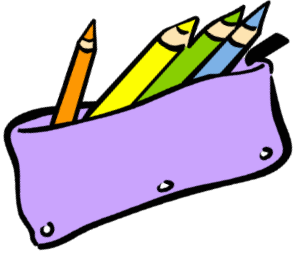
We are interested in finding out what books you have read over the summer. **Students should come prepared with one book to read for independent reading starting on the first day of school.**

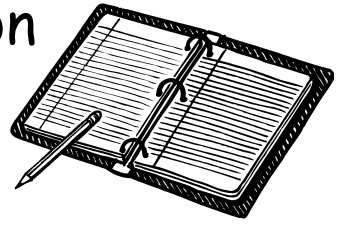
